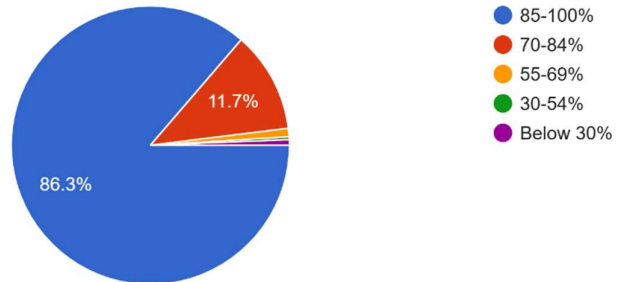

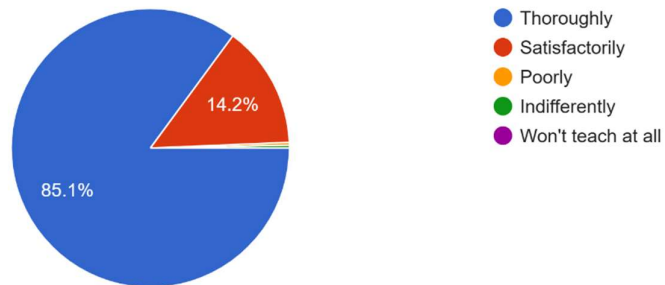
1. How much of the syllabus was covered by the teacher ?

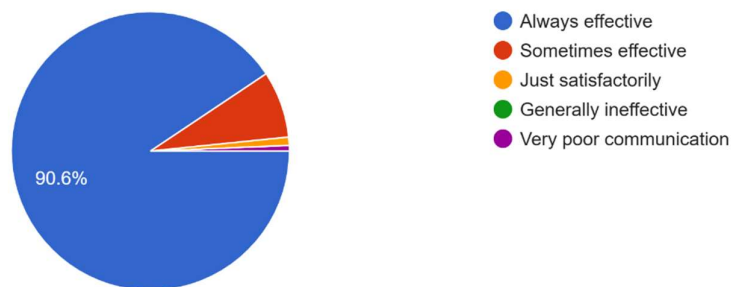
2. How well did your teacher prepare for the classes ?

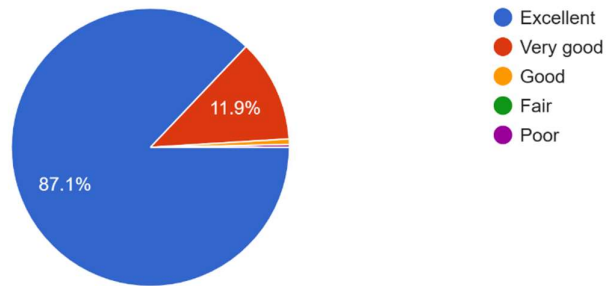


3. How well is the teacher able to communicate ?

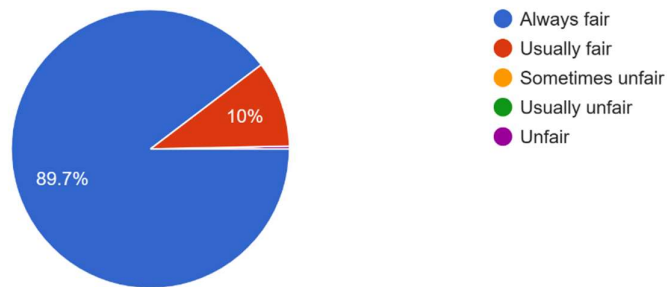

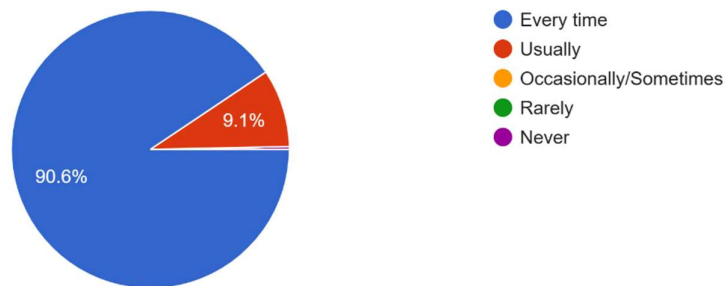
4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as

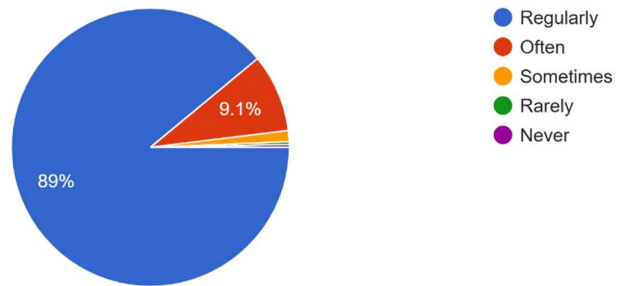


6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you ?

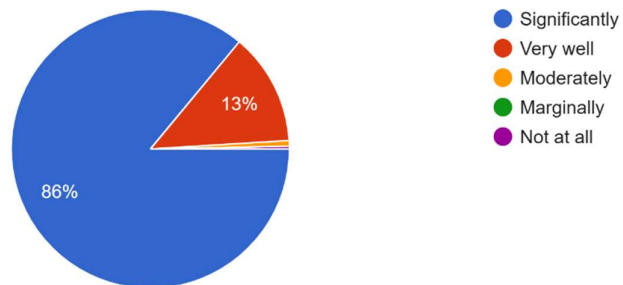
7. The teacher takes active interest in arranging field visits for students.

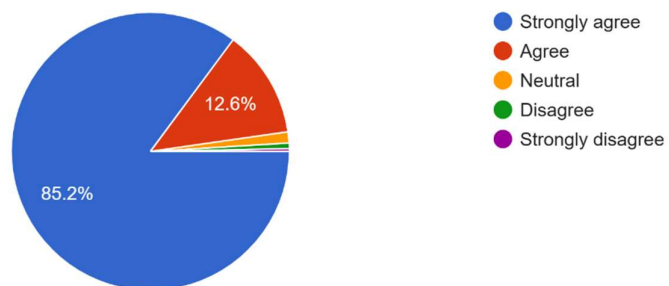

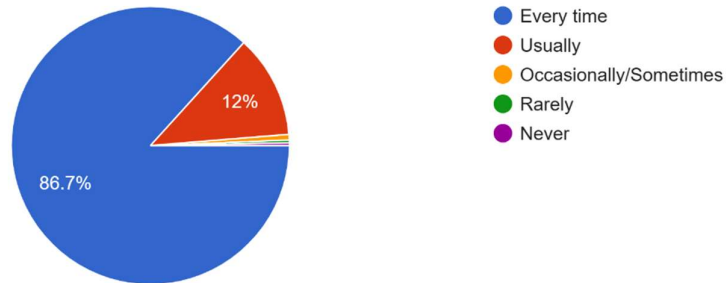

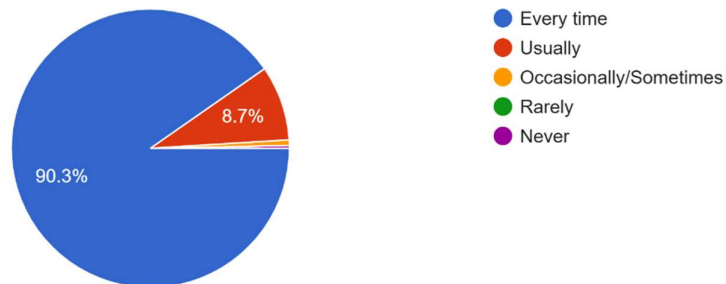

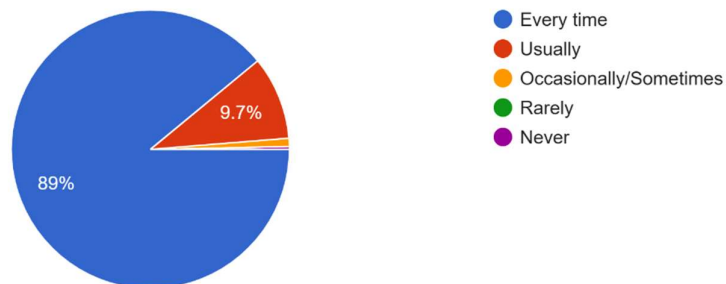

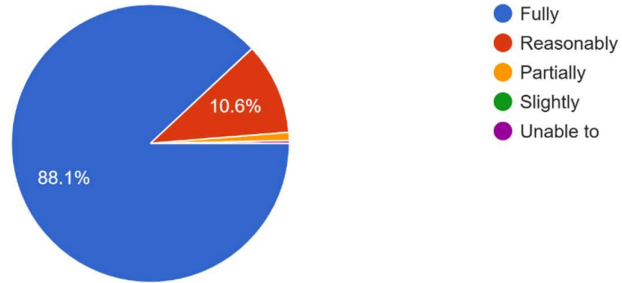

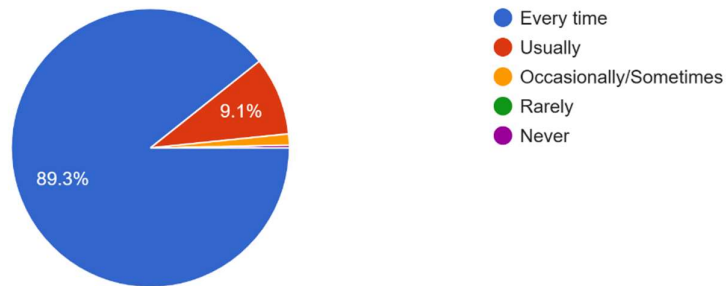

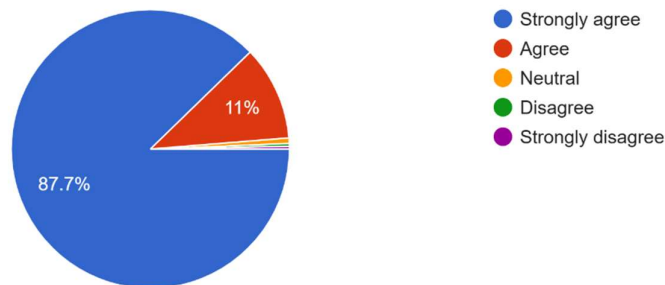
