Sub:- A.P.C.E.S. - Government Degree Colleges - Work load and Vacancy Position -Rationalization of Posts - Conversion and Shifting of Surplus Vacant posts existing in Government Degree Colleges to needy colleges - Orders - Issued.

Read:- 1. G.O.Ms.No.2510 Education, dated: 16.10.1965.
2. G.O.Ms.No.951 Education, dated: 02.05.1970.

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It has come to the light that there is no Workload in several subjects in several Government Degree Colleges in the state. It is also found that there are posts available in certain colleges where the workload is not justifying the number of posts sanctioned resulted in surplus. Similarly, in certain colleges where there is abundant workload in comparison to the posts sanctioned resulting in additional requirement of posts.

To streamline and to maintain balance in workload in all Government Degree Colleges it is necessary to transfer the Surplus vacant posts to the colleges where there is imminent need.

In the circumstances and in pursuance to the orders issued in the references read above the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Andhra Pradesh, Vijayawada here by orders for shifting of available surplus posts to the colleges where there is imminent need.

The details of the posts identified as surplus vacant and converted/shifted to the colleges is as mentioned in the Annexure appended to these Proceedings.

ORDER:

In the Govt.Order read above, Government have formulated certain guidelines for opening of new Government/Private Degree/Junior Colleges during 1983-84 and onwards as contained in Annexure.I to the said Govt.Order and also furnished a list of such colleges considered for opening during 1983-84 in Annexure.II to the said G.O. and requested the Director of Higher Education/Secretary, Board of Intermediate Education to obtain necessary feasibility report and the consent of the sponsors to abide by the conditions stipulated in the G.O. In the meanwhile some more representations for opening of some Degree/Junior Colleges have been received by the Government.

2. The Director of Higher Education/Secretary, Board of Intermediate Education, have submitted the particulars of the amounts deposited and other infrastructural facilities already provided and promised to be provided by the committees of these proposed colleges. Government after careful consideration of these particulars, have decided to relax the requirement of obtaining the feasibility report of the concerned University as required in G.O.Ms.No.306 Edn., dt.19-7-1983, as a special case, for this year, since there is no time left for obtaining these reports as the admissions in the Degree Colleges in the State have already commenced for 1983-84, pending obtaining affiliation from the Universities concerned by the college committees.

3. Government therefore, sanction the opening of the Govt. Degree Colleges mentioned in the Annexure to this order during the year 1983-84 temporarily subject to fulfilment of the following conditions, within a period of one year from the date of this order, if not already complied with.

- (1) The college committee should obtain the feasibility report from the concerned University and submit the same to Govt. through the Director of Higher Education, immediately.
- (2) The college committee should credit an amount of Rs.4.75 / 2.50 lakhs as the case may be as required, under the G.O. read above towards salaries, equipment etc. into the Government account under the receipt Head. "077 - Education - E. University and other Higher Education - M.H.15. Other receipts - S.H.(01) - Contributions and income from Endowments (to be opened)", if not already deposited.



3. The college committee should provide 15 acres of land and building with plinth area of 8,000 sq. ft. and register them in favour of Government.
4. The college committee should provide adequate temporary accommodation exclusively for Degree classes, from their own funds.
5. The college committee should construct permanent buildings for the college from their own funds within a period of 5 years at the latest. They should form a committee consisting of parents and other to raise adequate public contributions for construction of buildings as per the approved plans.
6. The college committee should provide furniture, equipment and library books etc. immediately as prescribed by the University concerned.
7. If the existing Govt. Junior College is to be upgraded into Govt. Degree College, the Junior and Degree Colleges sections shall exist separately either within the same premises or separately, in which case the college committee will have to provide necessary accommodation exclusively for the Degree College and also facilities like library, equipment, furniture etc.,
8. The post of Principal of the Junior College shall continue since the Government Junior College and the Govt. Degree College will function independently.
9. The college shall start with one section each in I year B.A., and B.Com., courses and one of the three optional subjects shall be restructured course, as approved by the University.
10. The medium of instruction should be Telugu. English medium can also be opened provided there is a minimum strength of 30 students in the course concerned and with the prior permission of the Govt.
11. The college committee should get affiliation to the college from the concerned University expeditiously.

4. The Government also sanction the creation of the following teaching and non-teaching staff to each of the colleges shown at Annexure - to this order as specified below:-

The above posts shall carry the usual pay and allowances admissible as per rules except for the part-time Lecturers post with a consolidated pay of Rs.400/- per month. The posts of Physical Director and Librarian shall not be filled during the current year (1983-84).

Pending posting of regular staff, the Director of Higher Education is requested to issue instructions to the Principals concerned to make part time arrangements of teaching staff on the basis of "offer of remuneration" for giving lecturers on hourly basis. The recruitment in respect of non-teaching staff shall be made in accordance with the existing rules.

5. Sanction is also accorded for incurring non-recurring expenditure of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees Fifty thousands only) towards furniture, books and other contingencies for each of the years 1983-84, 1984-85 and 1985-86 for each of the colleges specified in the Annexure to this order.

6. The expenditure on these colleges shall be met from the additional provision to be made in the Plan Budget for the current year and shall be debited to the Head of Account:

"277 Education - E.University and other Higher Education - M.H.10 Government Colleges - Scheme included in the Plan - S.H.(01)/(02) Government Degree Colleges for Men/Women (Plan) - (10) Salaries. 040 -/044 other office expenses - 150 Machinery and equipments."

7. The Principals of these colleges are permitted to incur the expenditure under contingencies within the ceilings specified above.

8. The Director of Higher Education shall ensure that the college committees fulfil all the conditions mentioned in para 3 above and also the conditions laid down in G.O. Ms.No.306 Edn., dt.19-7-1983, within one year from the date of this order.

9. The Director of Higher Education shall appoint an expert committee regionwise immediately to go round all the colleges sanctioned in this order to verify to what extent the respective sponsors have fulfilled the conditions laid down in G.O.Ms.No.306 Education, dated 19-7-83 and the time schedule within which they can fulfil these conditions and submit reports within 2 months.

If on the basis of the Expert Committee's report, wherever a college is found not viable in terms of students strength and infrastructure facilities available action will be taken to close down such an Institution and accommodate the students of that college in the neighbouring institutions.







Level in addition to the existing courses from the academic year 2021-22 as mentioned in the Annexure enclosed without any additional financial commitment to Government subject to the following conditions.

1. No additional posts will be sanctioned for the newly started courses in future.
2. No additional funds will be provided for building, equipment and other infrastructural facilities.
3. The existing Labs, equipment, man power etc. shall be utilized for the newly started courses.
4. The expenditure on salaries of the staff of the Market Oriented Courses shall be met from the additional special fee collected from the students.
5. The fee structure and expenditure procedure shall be as per the affiliating University rules.
6. Necessary affiliation from the University concerned has to be obtained and ensure that the said courses are started from the academic year 2021-22.
7. As per the reference 1st cited, all U.G. Courses in Telugu Medium are to be offered in English Medium only from this academic year 2021-22.
8. The Affiliating University is requested not to collect any affiliation fee for new courses offered for this academic year 2021-22.

The National Education Policy-2020, mainly emphasis, on improvement of quality of higher education, which plays an extremely important role in promoting human as well as societal wellbeing and in developing India as envisioned in its Constitution. Quality of higher education is must aim to develop good, thoughtful, well-rounded, and creative individuals. It must enable an individual to study one or more specialized areas of interest at a deep level, and also develop character, ethical and Constitutional values, intellectual curiosity, scientific temper, creativity, spirit of service. A quality higher education must enable personal accomplishment and enlightenment, constructive public engagement, and productive contribution to the society. It must prepare students for more meaningful and satisfying lives and work roles and enable economic independence.

Accordingly, the AP State Council of Higher Education (APSCHE) revised the curricular framework of General UG Programmes in accordance with NEP 2020 and Revised Curricular Structure of UGC. The major change in the proposed curriculum is a shift from three majors to single majors along with multiple entry and exit options. In this connection the Secretary, APSCHE, Mangalagiri, in his letter cited in the 1st reference, requested the Commissioner of Collegiate Education, AP (CCE-AP) to initiate the process of conversion of three majors into single majors in all Government Degree Colleges to be in effect from 2023-24 academic year

By taking into account of the prevailing scenario in the Colleges, to design the overall development of the student in multifaceted way with available infrastructure in the Colleges, sanctioned posts, admissions made in the Colleges for the past three years, series of meetings have been convened on conversion of existing UG Programs in Three Majors to Single Major from the Academic Year 2023 -2024, with **Principals, IQAC Coordinators and Subject Experts from the Government Degree Colleges**, to represent a student in a society to meet the global challenges after completion of their under graduation, in the job market, on the strength of the representations received from all Government Degree College Principals in the State, to change the old adopted programs to meet the global demand, series of meetings have been conducted in various platforms with subject experts and other academicians including all the Principals of Government Degree Colleges and during the course of deliberate discussions and suggestions made by them, at their request, the single major programmes are finalized.

In the above back drop, as per the proposals submitted by the Principals in various platforms and after having deliberate discussions, with all the Principals of Government Degree Colleges in the state, while enclosing the College wise, Single Major programme, permitted to run in their respective Colleges as mentioned against each Government Degree College, they are directed to take further steps, for the ensuing admissions being carried for the academic year 2023-2024.

Further they are also requested to intimate the changes to the respective Affiliating University Registrars in their jurisdiction for its recognition/affiliation of programmes and further necessary action.
